DISCUSSION	 Comprehensive School Improvement is still running, we will find out in October if we are out of CSI If we do not make it out of CSI, we will be in it for another 2 years When we get our letter grade we will have a little more information Our proficiency level didn't grown, but our students grew quite a bit in the other levels, which raised our overall raw score pretty significantly In all of our classes we are starting a bit higher than last year which gives us a better starting point. If we our out of CSI, the grant will continue through the school year We funded quite a few positions and trainings through the grant
